Arthritis and Podiatric Medicine - Walking Hand-in-Hand*	A presentation designed for a general audience of patients or healthcare professionals. Included in the presentation are facts and definitions of arthritis, common causes, symptoms and treatments. Members are encouraged to add clinical slides from their own collections as appropriate.
Arthritis and Your Feet	A presentation featuring general information about arthritis and how it affects the feet.
Bunions and Hammertoes*	A presentation designed for both patients and the public. It is fully customizable and can be used either as-is or with the addition of clinical slides.
Common Skin and Nail Conditions*	A presentation designed for patients and the public. Includes information regarding conditions that podiatrists deal with daily, including ingrown nails, warts, corns and calluses, and heel fissures, among others.

Seniors and Podiatric Medicine*	A presentation geared toward seniors that details common foot problems they may experience.
Sports Medicine and Your Feet (2 versions)*	A presentation on sports medicine designed for a general audience. The program is provided in two different versions, one with sports medicine-related photos and the other on a sports-themed template. Both presentations are identical in content and are fully customizable.
