Dr. Lambert specializes in complex medical and surgical treatment of the foot, ankle, and lower leg. He has trained in the U.S. and Europe to learn the application of the Ilizarov technique to correct a whole host of musculoskeletal disorders. He travels extensively to keep up with the latest techniques in Medicine and Surgery.
