The 2024 Summer Conference

ACCREDITATION INFORMATION

Podiatric Physician Accreditation Statement: The Florida Podiatric Medical Association (FPMA) is approved by the Council on Podiatric Medical Education (CPME) as a provider of continuing education in podiatric medicine. FPMA has approved this activity for a maximum of **8.5** Continuing Education Contact Hours (CECH) during this three-day conference, depending on lectures attended. This conference will take place June 7 - 9, 2024 at the Hyatt Regency Coconut Point Resort and Spa in Bonita Springs, Florida.

In accordance with the CPME, FPMA is required to monitor educational session attendance for verification of CECH. Cards for attendance verification will be provided to each 2024 Summer Conference Physician and X-Ray Assistant attendee when they check in at the conference.

Cost to the Learner: FPMA 2024 Summer Conference attendees paid a range of registration fees based on their current membership status in APMA and/or FPMA as well as the date they registered for the conference (the various registration fees were provided in the FPMA 2024 Summer Conference Physician registration form). Non-APMA/FPMA members paid the full registration fee of \$349 (by April 26, 2024) or \$399 (after April 26, 2024).




